How to match ReSound RIE and BTE hearing aids with the correct charger

Each charger type is offered with different inserts – known as the charging form factor (CFF) – which relate to a specific ReSound hearing aid collection or style.

The CFF is indicated with a number (see chart below) and is shown inside the charger bay and on the charger packaging.

ReSound offers rechargeable solutions with inductive charging and long battery life to keep your patients on the go.



CFF numbers 01 and 03 are not shown on the packaging just yet – please reference the number inside the charger.

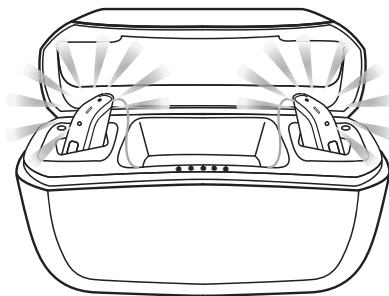
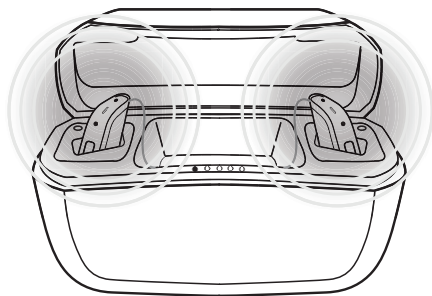

How to tell if the hearing aids are charging

Place the hearing aids in the charger and let the light indicator on the hearing aids guide you. For rechargeable Customs, the LED on the front of the charger will be your guidance.

You know that charging has started when the hearing aid lights blink slowly.



When fully charged, the hearing aid lights remain constant, not blinking.

The lights turn off when the hearing aids are removed from the charger.
