- 5.3 x Zip ties

Adjustable wall seal for central and mini-split systems. Used for both new and existing installations.






#### Installation




**1.** Assemble the left and right panel together.



- 3. Close the left and right panel, as shown in A
- **4**. Wrap the flexible sleeve around the lineset bundle and lock it in place, as shown in B
- **5**. Install the 3x screws to bond the left and right panels, as shown in C
- ${\bf 6}.$  Install the 4x screws to fix the panels to the wall, as shown in D



**2.** Place the assembled outlet seal around the refrigerant lineset bundle.



- **7**. Use the zip ties to tie the flexible sleeve around the lineset bundle, as shown in E
- 8. Caulk the back of the outlet seal, as shown in F
